

# How to Use AGI's Globeserver with STK/Author

## Requirements

- Any version of AGI Viewer
- STK/Advanced VO module
- STK/Author
- Internet access

STK/Author allows the user to publish an STK Scenario to a portable AGI Viewer file. Globeserver complements STK/Author by streaming imagery and terrain to AGI Viewer files without increasing their file size. As the "Author," you'll first need to create an STK Scenario which uses Globeserver. If you don't already have one please refer to the previous exercise, "How to Access AGI's Globeserver with STK." Give it a try by following the steps below.

## STEP 1

*Open a scenario containing a globe which refers to Globeserver.*

## STEP 2

*Go to the File Menu and select 'Export' then 'AGI Viewer File.'*

## STEP 3

*Uncheck 'Optimize Viewer file for size.' Under Graphics, check 'Use my current globe.'*

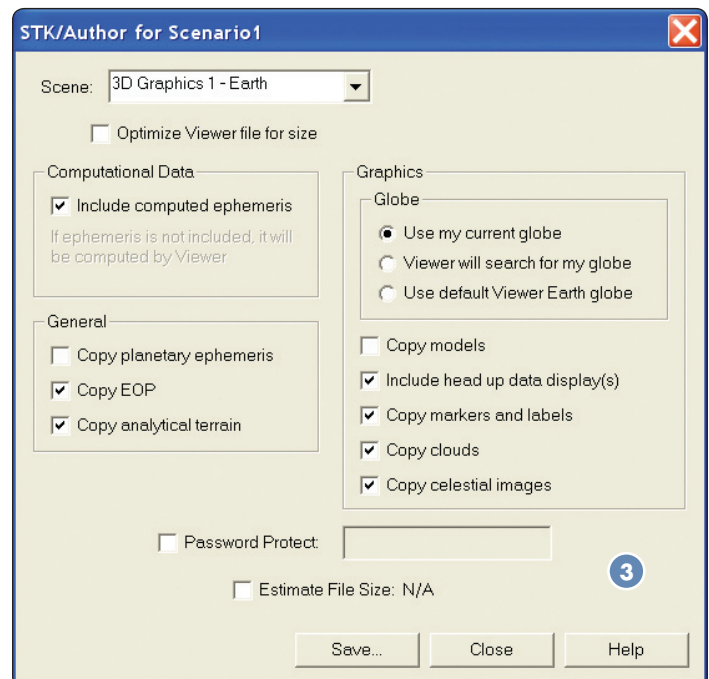
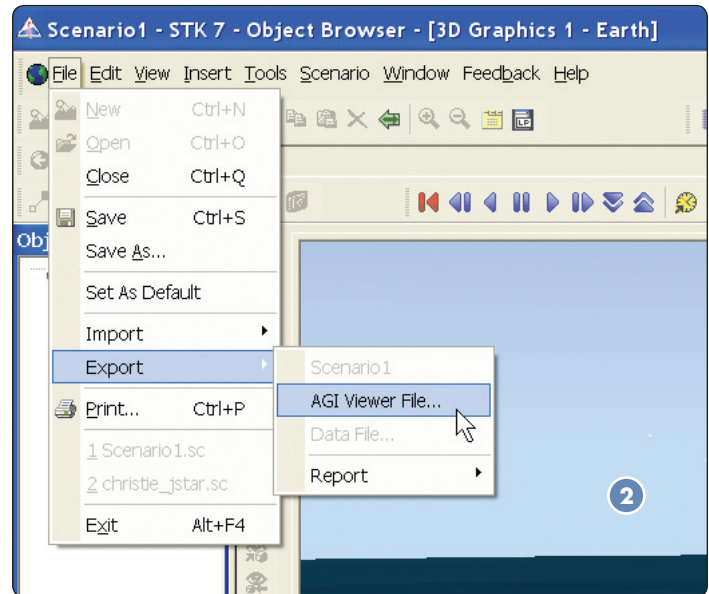
## STEP 4

*Click 'Save,' name the file, and then note the output location.*

## STEP 5

*Close STK and Open the AGI Viewer (.VDF) file you created. To do this, double-click on the file or open AGI Viewer and go to 'File -> Open.'*
